To the people of L.A. **Edgardo Duque** is an everyman, an Asian-American entrepreneur running a busy garage and a downtown lounge while **struggling with family** --- his estranged teenagers and ex-wife, an overbearing mother, a mentally ill stepfather, and a sister entangled in immigration. But to those who know him well, Edgardo is also a **genius** with flawless memory who copes with alcoholism, OCD, and gambling addiction.

Edgardo's public life covers his secret work as a **fixer for organized crime**. Sought for his discretion and ability to solve any problem, he became known as **"The Duke,"** a legend specializing in laundering money, fencing stolen goods, running guns, and brokering deals.

For years, Edgardo used his towering intellect to keep a delicate balance between his two lives, distancing his family and friends from the dangerous gangs he does business with and the city's special task force not far behind. However, upon his infamous brother's release from prison, he finds his two worlds spilling into each other, and must go to extremes to protect those he loves.
